Traditional Quarter of Panagia Dexia

The preservable quarter of "Panagia Dexia" is developed along the River Tripotamos, just beside the central commercial market of Veria. The Church of Panagia Dexia was built in the early 19th c. in the place of an older church of the 14th c.

There are two more old churches in Dimosthenous street: Church of St Nicholas and Church of St Paraskevi.

The Old Cathedral (11th c.)

The Old Cathedral of Veria is one of the greatest temples of the middle Byzantine period, which the bishop of the town had it built between 1070 and 1080. The Church inside presents some of the greatest wall painting works of the 12th, 13th and 14th c. Opposite the Church, there is an ancient plane tree where the Turks hanged Archbishop Arsenios in 1430, after taking Veria. In 1977 it was declared preserved natural monument.

Karachmet Bridge – Tripotamos River

The river that flows across the city of Veria is called "Tripotamos". Along the banks, the are 17 registered caves that were used as hermitages, corrals, water tunnels, ossuaries and the 16th c. stone bridge over Tripotamos river is one of the rare works by Turkish architect Karachmet (from whom it got its name) to survive to this day.

Havra Bridge – Tripotamos River

There are 10 bridges that connect the two sided of Tripotamos River. Havra Bridge connects

Traditional Jewish Quarter of Barbouta

The quarter is located next to Barbouta area, whose name comes from a fountain which is preserved until today. On the northwestern edge of the open courtyard of the Jewish Quarter with its cobbled streets and imposing mansions, there is the stone building of the old Jewish Synagogue with the rich and ornate decoration. The Jewish Synagogue in today's form was built in 1850 and it is the oldest in the northern Greece and one of the oldest in Europe. The interior of the Synagogue is impressive that is characterized by wood carved ceilings and vivid mosaic tiles.

Clock Tower Square (Raktivan)

It is the center of the modern city. The impressive building in front was the old courthouse. In front of the building, took place the delivery of the town to the Greek army by the Turkish commander on October 16, 1912. At the other side of the square, there is a memorial for the fallen of the WWII. Behind the courthouse there are some ruins left from the tower of Princess Vergina, wife of the last Duke of Veria. She drowned herself in Tripotamos River, after the city was occupied by the Ottomans. In the middle of Veroi street, there is another historical plane tree where the Ottomans hanged the fighter Karadimos and his boys in 1705.

Apostle Paul's Tribune, a global pilgrimage

Paul visited Veria twice; in 56 AD and at the beginning of 57 AD during his journey from Asia Minor to Greece, to teach the life of Jesus to the people of the region. Paul's the Apostle passage through Veria and the impact of his preaching, reveal the significance of the town at the first steps of Christianity. The impressively large number of churches gave the city the nickname "Little Jerusalem" Today, at the city center, 46 Byzantine and post Byzantine churches with beautiful frescoes are well preserved.

The Byzantine Museum of Veria

The Byzantine Museum of Veria is housed in a majestic 1911 landmark industrial building known as the Mill of Mark, which is located close to the traditional district Kyriotissa next to the ancient town wall. The permanent collection includes impressive icons, murals from churches, mosaics, architectural sculptures, pottery art and coins, manuscripts and burial findings. The exhibits are housed in three floors, 720 square meters of total area.

Traditional Quarter of Kyriotissa

Kyriotissa is a picturesque quarter with a maze of narrow streets and dead ends, tall buildings, mansions and gardens with tall yards that evoke the traditional houses of the Balkans in the 18th and 19th century. Behind the tall fences and adjacent alleys emerge small stone Christian and Byzantine churches. One of the most impressive is the Church of Saint Savvas from the 14th c. **GPS Location/Coordinates:** Traditional Quarter of Kyriotissa, Gr. Xenopoulou, Veria /

Veria City Hall

The City Hall was built by the Greek Christians, just before the liberation of the city. It initially functioned as a school. During the Balkan wars it served as a military hospital and barracks for Evzones and in World War I it was requisitioned by the French army.

After the conquest of Macedonia by the Romans (168 B.C.), Veria developed into a great administrative, spiritual and financial centre. The connection between Egnatia Road and the city of Veria by a paved road dating back to the 2nd century, part of which has been found and is exposed along Mitropoleos Street.

Elia Square

The "Elia" square is the city's meeting point. The walkway stretches along the Anoixeos Avenue and ends at the Archaeological Museum of Veria. Along the Avenue, the visitor is viewing the green plain of Imathia and the neoclassical mansions of the 19th century.

The Archaeological Museum

The Archaeological Museum of Veria exhibits the antiquities found in the Region of Imathia, from the Late Stone Age till the Hellenistic Period. At the entrance of the museum, the enormous Medusa's marble head is dominant, that was adjusted at the north gate of the ancient walls of Veria to keep the enemies away from the town. At the reception hall stands the impressive marble statue of the river god Olganos in the figure of Alexander the Great.

Archaeological site of Saint Patapios

The Church of Saint Patapios was built in the 15th century on the ruins of two older religious constructions, an early Christian baptistery of the 4th century and a big early Christian basilica of the 5th century. The Church of Saint Patapios preserves till today murals from the original temple that date back to the period between 15th and 18th century.

Old Central Market

The area known as "Teneketzidika" give a sense of the old central market. Some of the traditional workshops of handmade items are still operating. There are several shops since the beginning of the 20th century. From M. Alexandrou Street, the market goes up to Kentrikis Street to the level of Platanon Street and down from Filippou Street again to M. Alexandrou Street.

Admission: Free

Tip: Buy handmade household items. Taste and buy local delicacies. Break for coffee or drink at the cafés — bars.



Promitheas Bridge (Bobolis)

The Bombolis Bridge - near the current Thermopylae bridge - is the bridge where the open food market takes place. From the Bridge there is access to the Tripotamos River.

GPS Location/Coordinates: Promitheas Bridge (Bobolis) / G6F2+MW Veria

Opening hours: 24 hours (outdoor attraction)

Distance from previous point / Walking duration / Visiting duration: 350 m. / 5' / 5'

Admission: Free

Tip: Cross the bridge and visit the Jewish Cemeteries and the Holocaust Memorial (350 m. walking distance).
